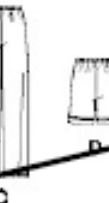

Thread, C, D: 1½ yd. of ¼" wide Wrights® twill tape for drawstring. ½ yd. of 2½" wide elastic for back waist. Look for Simplicity notions and Simplicity Trims™ or Wrights® Trims.

- On the envelope back, you will need your **BODY MEASUREMENTS, SIZE, and VIEWS** to help determine how many yards of fabric you will need
- Commercial pattern sizes are **NOT THE SAME** as **READY-TO-WEAR SIZES**

PATTERN envelope

Suggested Fabrics

- Tells what **TYPE OF FABRIC** would be best for the pattern
- Some Patterns are made especially for **KNITS** that won't fit correctly if made with a **WOVEN** fabric
- Allow extra fabric to match **PLAIDS** or **STRIPES**

Notions

- What are notions? EXTRA ITEMS NEEDED FOR COMPLETING A PROJECT BESIDES FABRIC
- Examples: ELASTIC, ZIPPERS, THREAD, BUTTONS, SNAPS, CORDING, BIAS TAPE, etc

Finished Garment Measurements & Ease

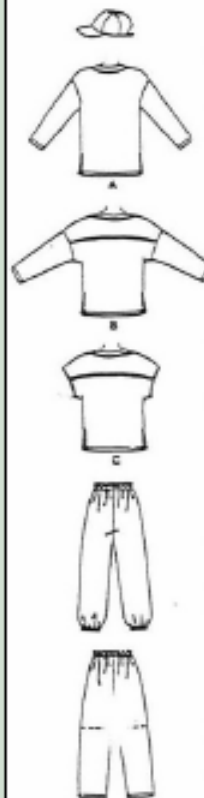
- What are finished garment measurements? MEASUREMENT OF THE COMPLETED PROJECT AT SPECIFIC POINTS LIKE THE CHEST & HIPS FOR EACH SIZE.
- Why are they so important? THEY HELP DETERMINE THAT THE SIZE CHOSEN WILL FIT THE WAY DESIRED
- What is ease? AMOUNT OF FULLNESS NEEDED FOR MOVEMENT, COMFORT & DESIGN.
 - The difference between the BODY MEASUREMENTS and FINISHED GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

MISSES', MEN'S OR TEEN-BOYS' SHIRTS, PULL-ON PANTS OR SHORTS AND CAP: Pull-on pants or shorts with side seam pockets have double elastic waistline casing. Pants have elasticized leg edges. Loose-fitting baseball shirt, **View A** has side slits, long sleeves, top-stitching and optional braid trim. Pullover "hospital" shirt **View B** and **C** has back yoke, outside and inside patch pockets, side slits and V-neckline with self band. **View B** has long sleeves. Faced cap has back elastic.

The guidesheet is the **INSTRUCTIONS** for how to complete the garments included in the pattern.

- **Sewing Instructions**



PATTERN GUIDESHEET

It is a good idea to go through your guidesheet & **HIGHLIGHT** everything that goes along with your pattern **VIEW** including:

- Pattern Pieces
- Cutting Layout
- Construction Steps



PREPARE The FABRIC

PRESHRINK 100% cotton fabric before use.

Fabric can be straightened by pulling the fabric on the **BIAS**.

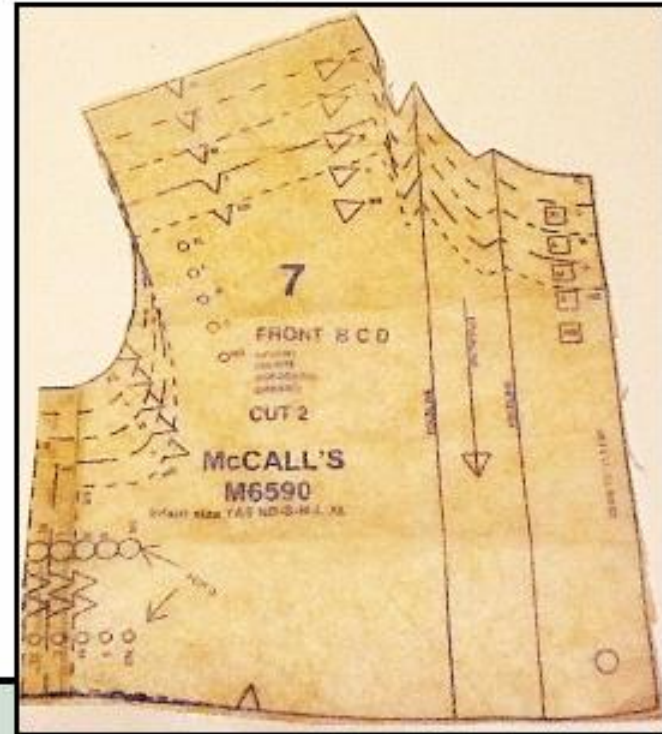
First between one set of cornersthen between the other set.



PATTERN TISSUE

The pattern tissue includes all the **SHAPES** or **PATTERN PIECES** needed to make a garment in **CONSTRUCTION**.

Each piece has many **SYMBOLS** that will be crucial to the **CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT**



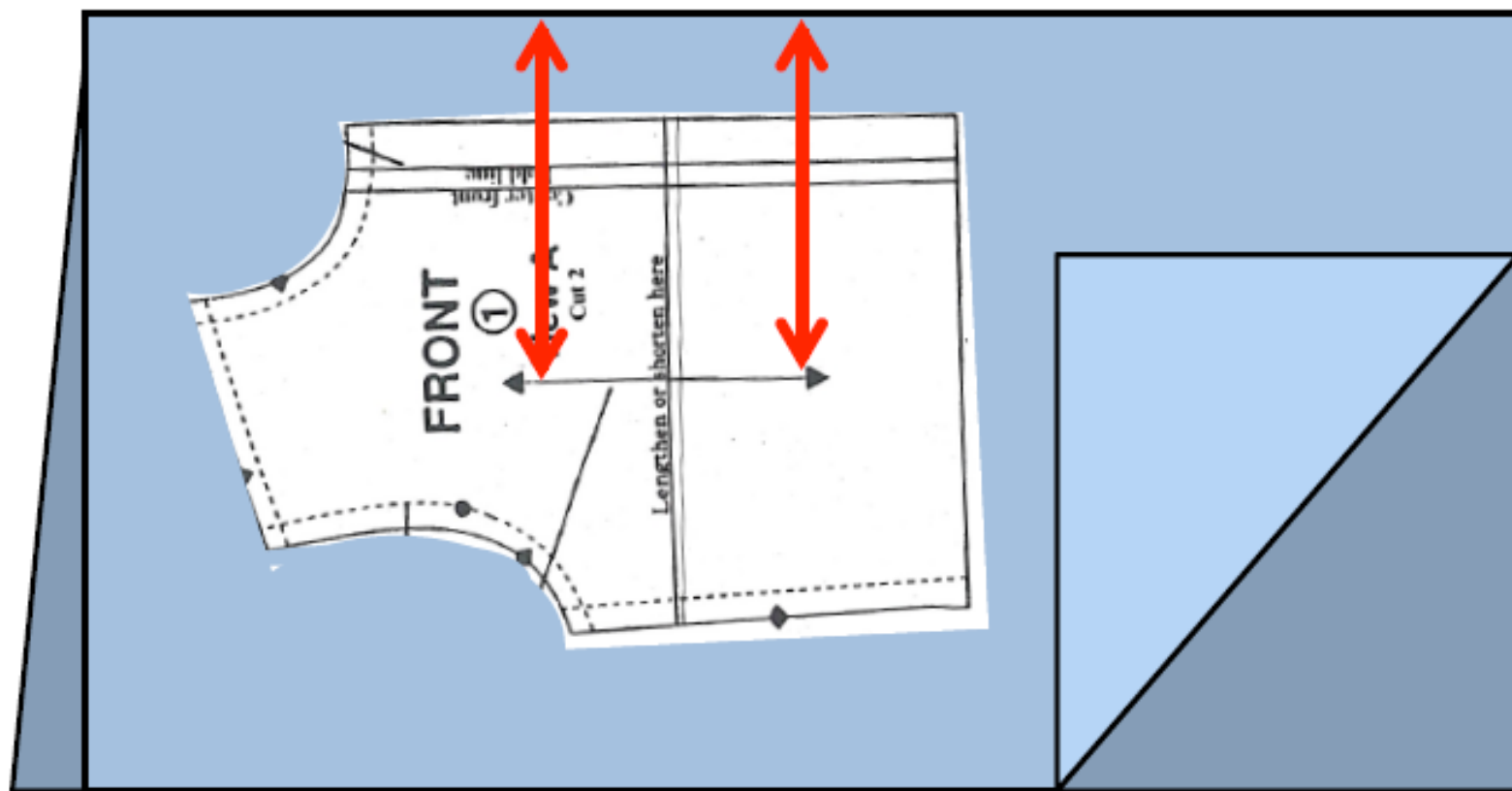
GRAINLINE/STRAIGHT OF GRAIN

- Indicates the **PLACEMENT** of pattern piece on the fabric grain.
- Grain line must be placed exactly PARALLEL to the selvage. (use the rotary ruler to check)



GRAINLINE/STRAIGHT OF GRAIN

Exactly PARALLEL to the selvage



PLACE ON FOLD

- Indicates the **PLACEMENT** of pattern piece **ON THE FOLD** of the fabric.
 - Usually seen at center front or back.



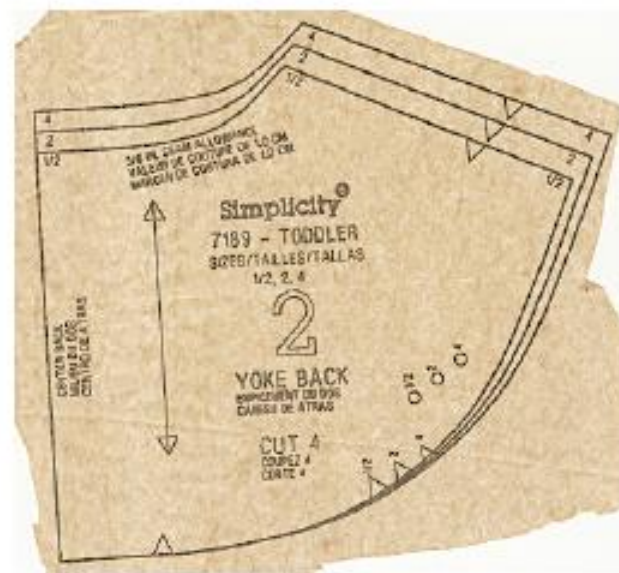
PLACE ON FOLD

Placed on the fold of the fabric



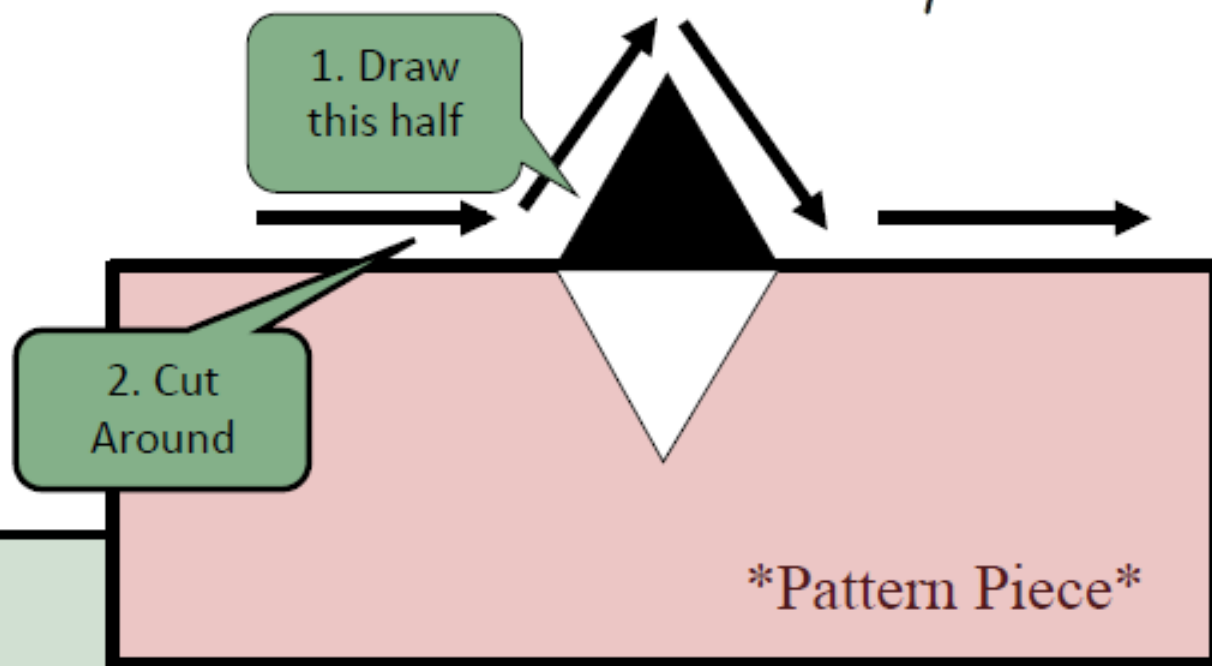
SIZING LINES

- Modern Multi-size patterns often have a unique line for each size



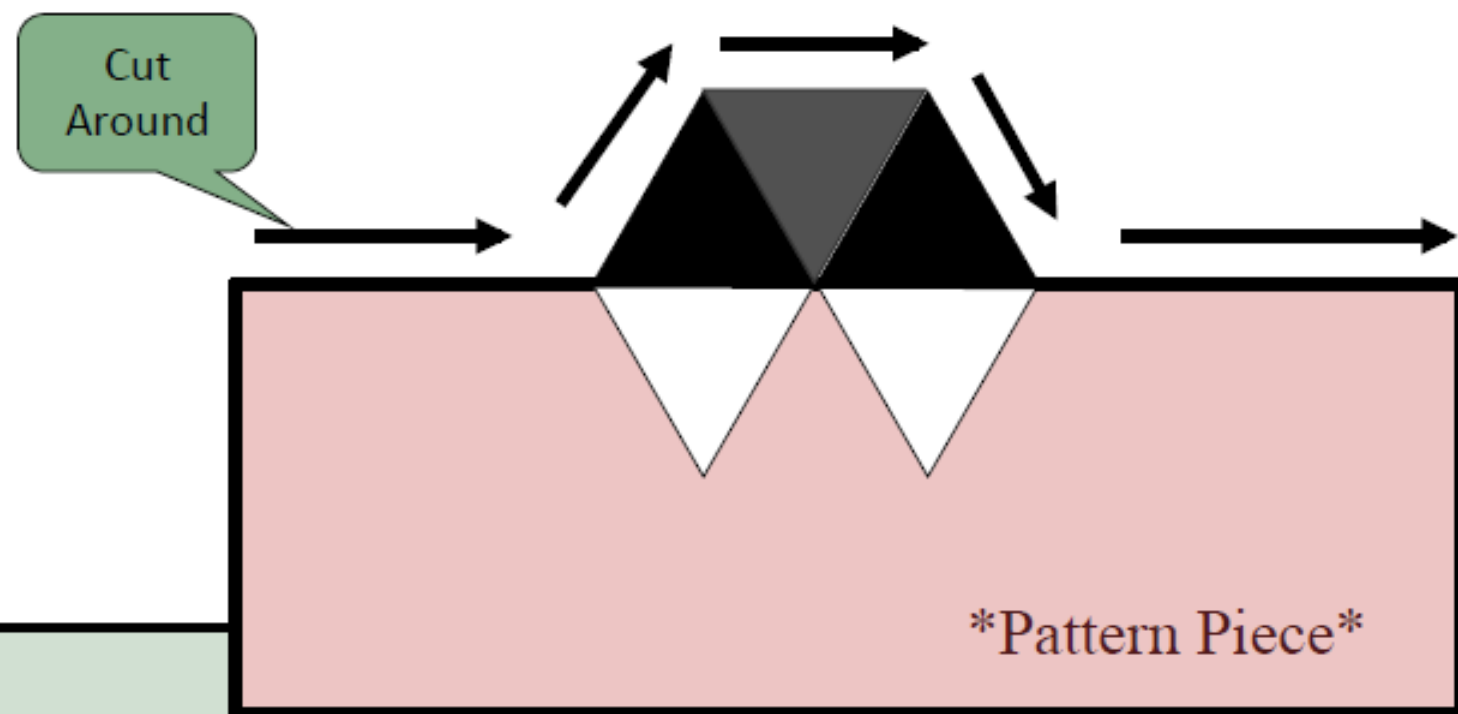
NOTCHES

- Used for matching seams and joining garment pieces.
- Should extend beyond the cutting line.
- On multi-sized patterns the notches often appear as triangles. You should DRAW THE OTHER HALF before you cut the fabric.

Double & Triple Notches: CUT THEM AS ONE LONG BLOCK

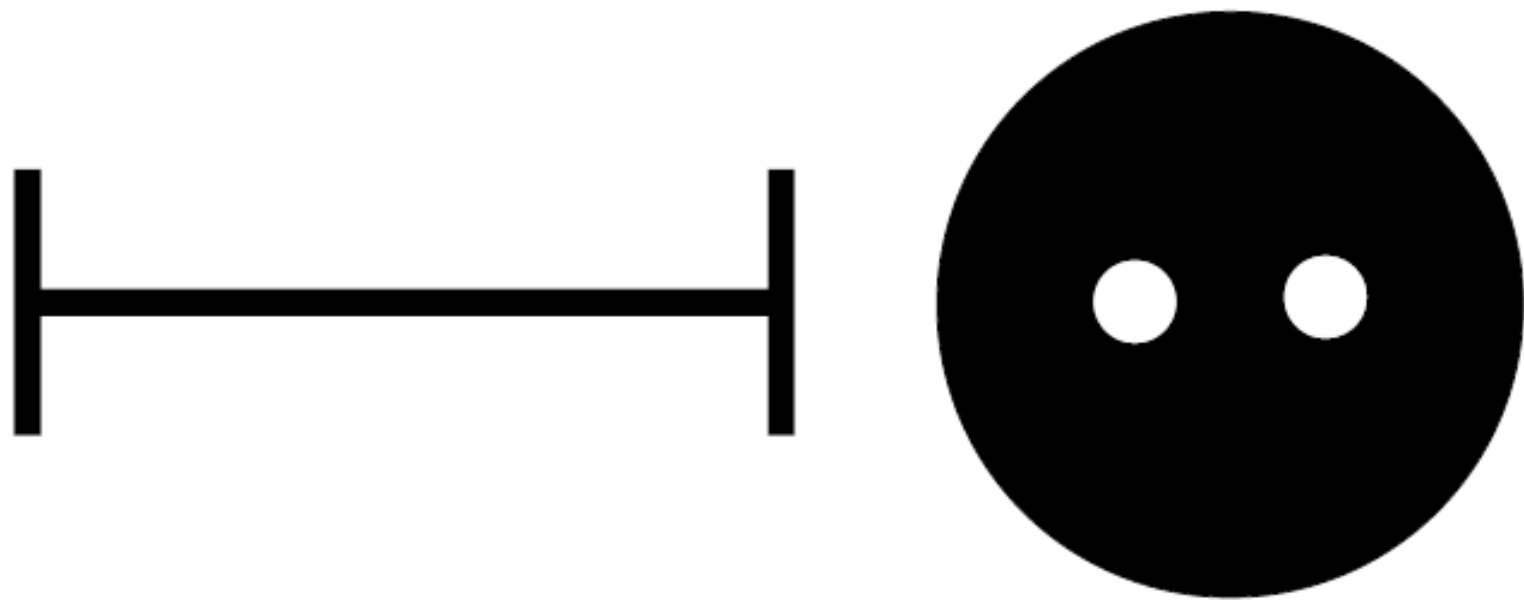
DOTS, SQUARES, OR TRIANGLES

- Used to **MATCH** fabric pieces, especially in areas requiring easing like sleeves.
- May be with in garment piece to indicate **PLACEMENT** of details like pockets or zippers.



BUTTONHOLE PLACEMENT

- Shows exact LOCATION and LENGTH of each buttonhole



ADJUSTMENT LINES

- Indicates where pattern can best & easiest be lengthened/shortened.



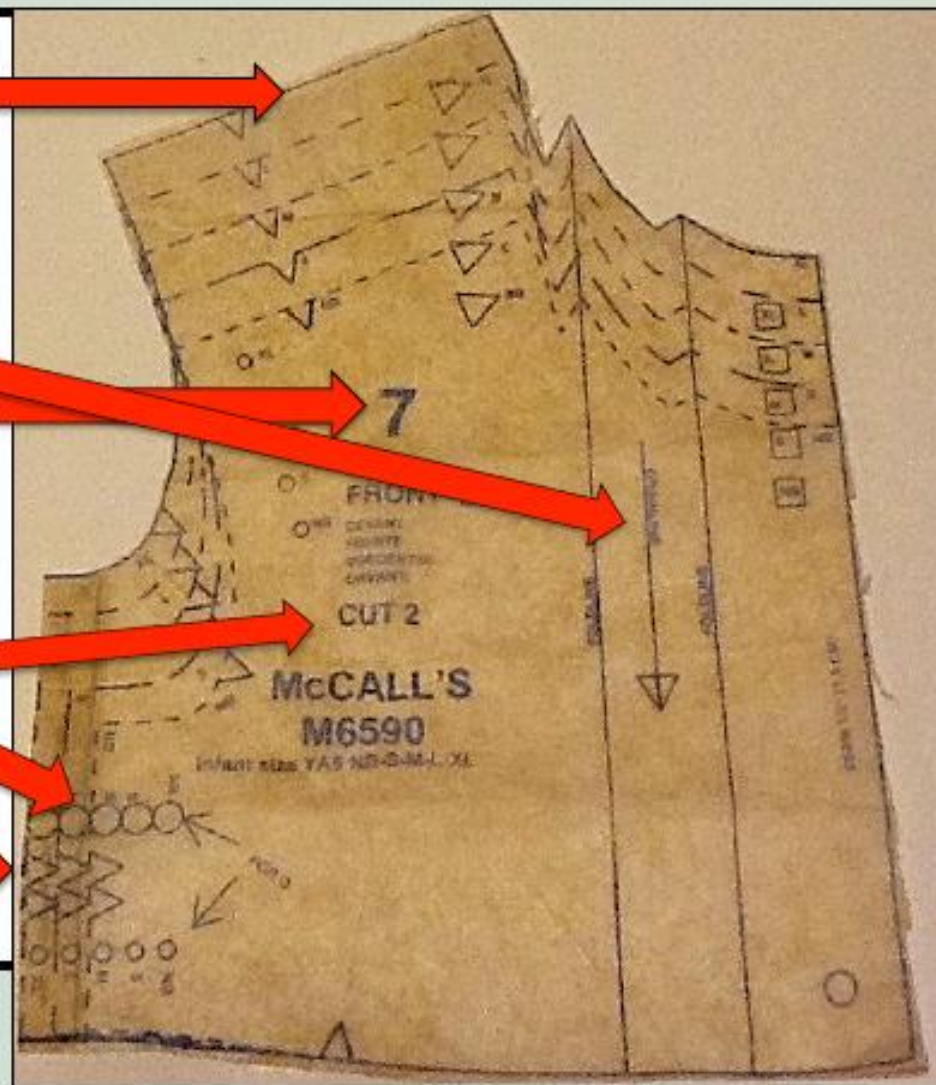

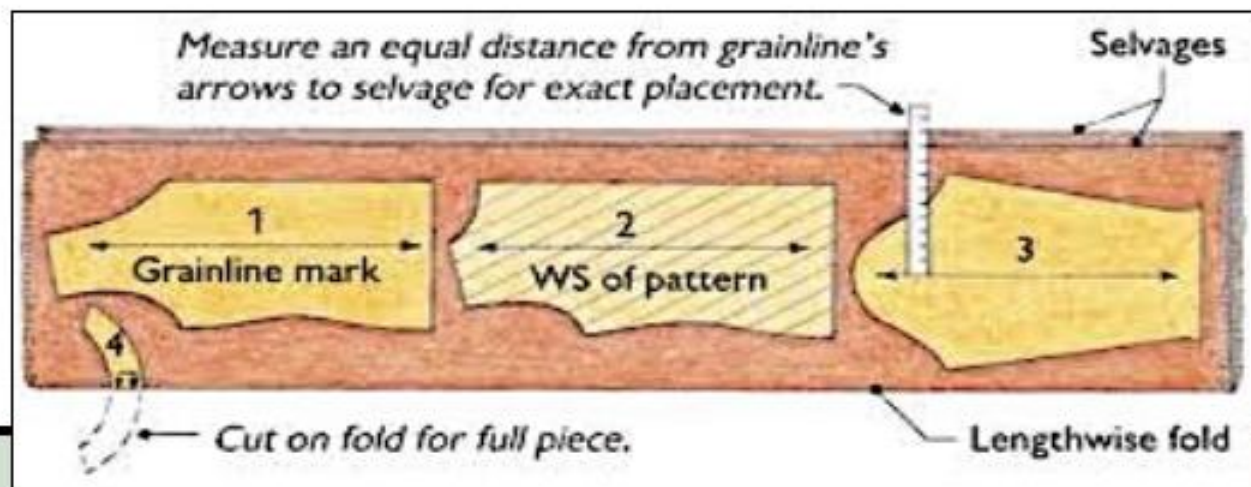

PATTERN LAYOUT

Patterns are cut with the **GRAINLINE** running **EXACTLY** parallel to the lengthwise grain because it provides more **STRENGTH & STABILITY**

When using a one-way design fabric, **BUY** more fabric. Pattern pieces **MUST** all **FACE** the **SAME DIRECTION** on the fabric



PATTERN LAYOUT

To correctly pin a pattern to the fabric, pins should be **INSIDE** the cutting line.

If using shears, keep the **FLAT SIDE** on the table & always keep the fabric **FLAT ON THE TABLE** when cutting.



Mark pattern pieces **AFTER** cutting them out but before **REMOVING THE PATTERN PIECES**.
